

Registration is open for all Junior Skills events. To register the competitors/teams go to [skillscanada.bc.ca](http://skillscanada.bc.ca), log in as a teacher, choose your event, and follow the prompts. The Tech Chairs or teachers can register their competitors; there are limits for each event as follows:

Sumo Robots –	individual event max 20 competitors
VEX IQ Robotics –	max 15 teams
Gravity Vehicle –	teams up to 4 and max 12 teams
Spaghetti Bridge –	teams up to 3 and max 14 teams
Wind Turbine –	teams up to 3 and max 5 teams
Potential Energy Vehicle –	teams of 2 max 15 teams
